

# Flourish Envelope Papercut Project

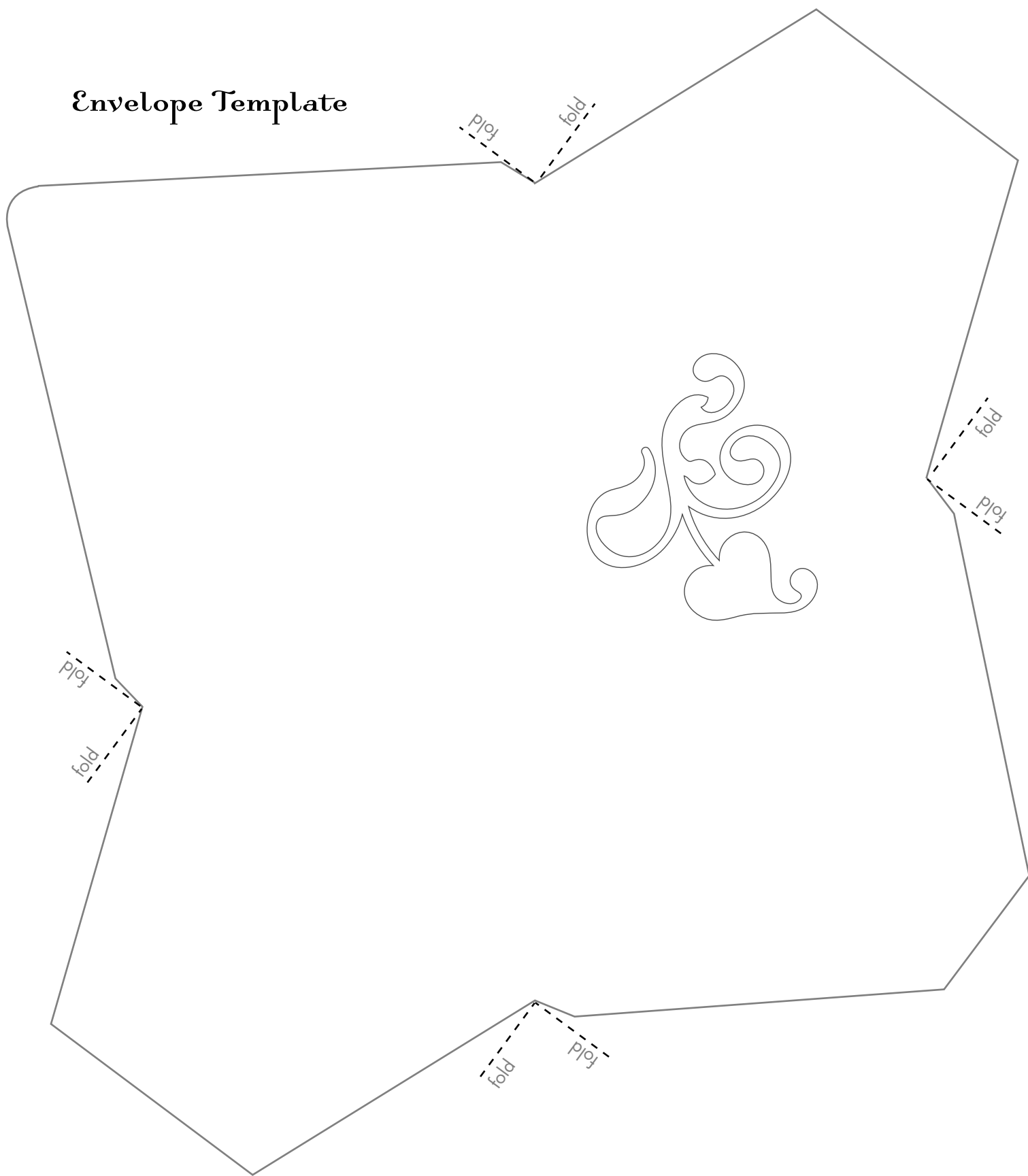
**Materials:**

- Two pieces of scrapbooking paper or cardstock in either 8.5"x11" or 12"x12"
- X-acto Knife
- Cutting Mat
- Ruler
- Glue Stick or Rubber Cement

**Directions:**

- If you are working with 12"x12" paper, trim it down to 8.5"x11" and reserve remainder.
- Print the envelope template on one paper and the envelope liner on a contrasting paper.
- Cut the envelope liner out and put aside for now.
- Using an X-acto knife, carefully cut the flourish out and reserve the cutout. Do not cut the envelope out at this time.
- Gently score the envelope along the fold lines.
- Using a glue stick or rubber cement, adhere liner to the envelope. When dry, gently score liner following the guidelines on the envelope template.
- Cut the envelope out. Fold. Glue. Done!
- Using the reserved scrap paper, cut a note card to 3.5" x 5". Glue your paper flourish cutout to the card to have a matching notecard.
- Address. Apply postage. Post!
